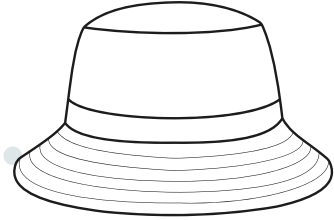

Each eligible child receives two \$100 vouchers per year

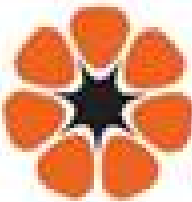
Open to children aged 5+, enrolled in an NT school or registered for home-schooling

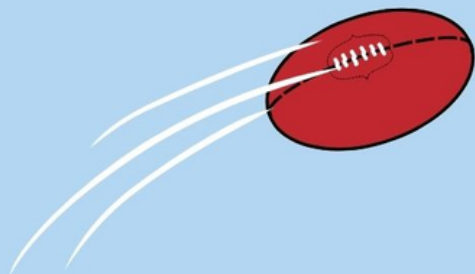
