Primary objective

Provide initiative and leadership in the development and implementation of school and departmental policies and procedures, educational programs and supervision of staff and students to achieve optimal educational outcomes for students with disability and special educational needs.

Context statement

Katherine South Primary School is an open plan school of approximately 250 students. The primary school is located in Katherine South on Riverbank Drive and includes Preschool to year 6. Of the student enrolment, approximately 37% are Indigenous. The school is a learning community of multi-age classes with a clear focus on inclusiveness, celebrating diversity and growing a strong sense of community.

Key duties and responsibilities

1. Lead school staff to develop, implement and maintain inclusive practices outlined in a range of systemic and school based policies.
2. Provide leadership advice and support to staff in the areas of student wellbeing through instructional leadership, coaching and mentoring.
3. Lead processes that support students with additional needs including profiling, referral processes, educational adjustment plans, positive behaviour support plans, assessment and data collection and analysis.
4. Support staff to plan and implement high impact teaching strategies that respond to student learning needs.
5. Work collaboratively with student support services, families and external agencies to support students with wellbeing, learning, transitions and pathways.

Selection criteria

Essential

1. Registration with the Northern Territory Teacher Registration Board.
2. Highly developed knowledge of students with complex social and emotional needs and demonstrated ability to plan and implement high impact evidence-based intervention strategies to support their learning.
3. Demonstrated knowledge of and experience in, the implementation of school-wide social and emotional learning programs.
4. Proven ability to successfully lead, plan and apply effective classroom management strategies that contribute to establishing and maintaining positive relationships and a supportive learning environment.
5. Proven ability to lead and work collaboratively and communicate effectively with colleagues, parents, external agencies and members of the local school community to establish and develop productive partnerships to achieve optimal educational outcomes and transitions.
6. Demonstrated ability to maintain effective student records and educational adjustment plans to improve educational outcomes for students.
